PLEASURE DRIVING JUDGE CANDIDATES:

Article 130.7.a: No applicant will be considered for promotion from Recorded to Registered status in the Pleasure Driving division unless he has adjudicated or served as Learner at after achieving his recorded status in at least four Pleasure Driving competitions with ADS recognized Judges who must have completed and returned an evaluation form on the applicant. At least 2 of these competitions must be ADS sanctioned. All applicants for Registered Judge are strongly encouraged to have some experience with four-in-hands. This experience may be either as a competitor or as an official in either Pleasure or Combined Driving . An applicants competitive experience may be considered during the promotion process. Evaluations of the applicant from the ADS officials and organizers at these competitions must be completed and returned to the ADS office.

COMBINED DRIVING JUDGE CANDIDATES

Article 130.7.b: In the combined driving division, applicants for promotion are strongly encouraged to have served as President of the Jury at a sanctioned competition at the Training, Preliminary, or Intermediate level. Additionally the applicant must **officiate three times at the Training, Preliminary or Intermediate level**, and serve as a jury member a **minimum of 2 times at the advanced level** within a period of three years. All applicants for Registered Judge are strongly encouraged to have some experience with four-in-hands. This experience may be either as a competitor or as an official in either Pleasure o Combined Driving. An applicant’s competitive experience at the Advanced Level in Combined Driving may be considered during the promotion process. Evaluations of the applicant from the ADS officials and organizers at these competitions must be completed and returned to the ADS office.

Article 130.7.c: In the Dressage Division, applicants for promotion must officiate a minimum of 3 times at the Training, Preliminary, or Intermediate Level and serve as a Jury Member a minimum of 2 times at the Advanced Level within a period of 3 years. All applicants for Registered Judge are strongly encouraged to have some experience with four-in-hands. This experience may be either as a competitor or as an official in either Pleasure or Combined Driving.
